


Controlled measures in place



Face coverings

Face covering to be worn within the setting. If you are unable to wear a face covering then you will need to ring the bell and a staff member will assist you so you do not enter the building. All staff to wear face covering when they are not in their own bubbles



Only one parent/ carer to accompany children within the setting

Only one parent/ carer to accompany children within the setting to limit the amount of people within the setting




Queue Management – Entrance through main door then Exit of babies

Use marked doors to enter and exit the building to limit people in one area at any one time.



No Visitors

No Visitors will be allowed within the a setting unless essential



Time Spent Inside 2m Social Distancing Guidelines Minimised At All Times.

Time spent within 2m social distance, when speaking to parents/carers, will be minimised at all times
Please respect this rule when by other parents/carers



Good Hygiene Procedures

All staff and visitors to adhere to the stringent infection control hygiene protocols as detailed
Use of sanitiser on entrance and exit of the setting, children will be encouraged to wash their hand on arrival and their departure from the setting



Regular Cleaning Of Common Areas

Common areas where people pass through are to be cleaned frequently but specific attention to be paid to areas where people spend more time or common touchpoints
These will be cleaned more intensely/frequently

Self Isolation

For those displaying symptoms of a high or raised temperature or new/persistent cough, isolation should be exercised immediately

Should individuals live with those displaying symptoms, they should isolate for 10 days
